The **SYMPHONIA** will present the Florida premier of ***“I Will Not Remain Silent,”*** a violin concerto composed by Bruce Adolphe. The piece is a musical biography that honors the late Rabbi Joachim Prinz, an outspoken rabbi who fled Berlin for the United States in 1937, as Hitler was rising to power. As a Jew in America, Prinz strongly related to the struggles and prejudice

experienced by African Americans, and he ultimately became a prominent civil rights activist who worked tirelessly alongside Dr. Martin Luther King.
